Rhus aromatica 'Gro-Lo' is a great selection for that sunny slope you don't want to mow, or as a low growing accent plant. Also called "Gro-Lo Sumac", this member of the sumac family is NOT POISONOUS. Its berries are relished by birds. This carefree plant spreads to 6'-8' wide and tolerates clay, dry, sandy, rocky or shallow soil. At 2' tall, it is high enough to shade out many low growing weeds. Full to part sun, fast growing. Plant several in a group for mass impact. The fall color can't be beat!
