You don't need a swamp to grow Quercus bicolor, Swamp White Oak. This adaptable oak tolerates standing water or dry sites, making it a popular landscape tree. It's even drought tolerant! The botanic designation bicolor refers to the leaves: glossy dark green above and velvety white below, turning golden in the fall. If you are looking for bird or butterfly value, there is no better tree than an oak. According to research by Doug Tallamy (author of *Bringing Nature Home*) oaks support over 500 species of Lepidoptera. We have a few lovely 12'+ specimens that have just been reduced in price. Native Grasses come into their own in the fall. Pictured above is Purple Love Grass, a relatively short beauty at 12"-18". This compact mound forming grass prefers part sun to sun, and dry to moist well drained soil.
