ATLANTIC WHITE CEDAR:

Looking for a slender evergreen? Atlantic White Cedar (*Chamaecyparis thyoides*) reaches about 40 feet with a width of about 10' or so. This adaptable evergreen will provide year round appeal as well as food and cover for songbirds.

Atlantic White Cedars are found naturally on wet ground or in swamps, sometimes on sandy soils, and are adapted to average garden soil as well. Listed as an 'extirpated' plant in Pennsylvania, it no longer occurs naturally in the wild.

The leaves of Atlantic White Cedar are the sole food for larvae of the rare Hessel's Hairstreak Butterfly.

We have a crop of seed grown Atlantic White Cedar as well as the selection 'Yankee Blue', which has bluish gray foliage (pictured above).

All plants at Edge of the Woods are nursery propagated. We do not collect from the wild.
