The attractive dark green clumping foliage sends up vivid red flowers. Our young plants are ready for your garden and will bloom next season to provide nectar for hummingbirds.

Here's One Way To Help Pollinators

Most of the native bees (which do the yeoman's work of pollination) are stingless, ground nesting species. They need access to bare soil or hollow stems to lay their eggs. So do them a favor: leave a few dormant perennial stalks up in your garden, and go easy on the mulch.
