This handsome shrub is commonly found streamside or on shorelines, and can form thickets in shallow water or saturated soil. Its foliage is a glossy dark green and it will grow in sun to shade as long as the site is moist. It is a 'nitrogen-fixer' which means it can grow in low-nutrient soils and provide nutrient to other species.

If you have a moist or wet site you can create a wonderful habitat area for songbirds and wildlife using Hazel Alder, Swamp Rose, ButtonBush, and Clethra. All of these plants are in stock now, and 10% off through Friday August 15. Shop early for best selection.
