MAPLE MADNESS

..so many native maples!

Red Maple: Red flowers spring, brilliant fall color, tolerates moist to wet, clay soil OK, full sun. Shade tree reaching 40'.

Sugar Maple: Amazing fall color. Eventually reaches 60' with spreading canopy of dense shade. Slow grower. Prefers moist soil, sun to part sun.

Mountain Maple: 20'-35' understory tree. Occurs naturally on cool, moist, wooded hillsides. Shade to part shade.

Silver Maple: Fast growing shade tree. becoming 80' tall with wide canopy. Leaves shimmer in the breeze. Full sun to part shade. Can tolerate some flooding.



American Yellowwood - a Hard to Find Native!

Sun to Light Shade

Moist soil, occurs naturally in bottom lands.

Small tree reaching 30 ft or so, with unique white flowers in spring.

Good source of nectar for pollinators.

Did you know that the native arborvitae, also called White Cedar, was probably the first American plant introduced to Europe? It can tolerate moist to wet conditions and provides food and cover for birds. Our selection ranges in size from 2' to 5' and from \$15 to \$30.
