Bring life to your landscape with native plants



Serviceberry, a versatile four-season landscape plant, is shown here mingling with red maple against a crisp spring morning sky. This multi-stemmed large shrub or small tree blooms each spring with delicate white flowers, which are followed by edible berries. The small leaves dance in the breeze and are whisked quickly away by autumn breezes. The delicate branch structure will delight all winter. Also called shadbush, it blooms when the shad begin their upstream migration.

It prefers full sun, tolerates some shade and is suitable to dry to moist soil. The birds love the berries. Place it where you can enjoy watching it from your favorite easy-chair.

If you are looking to add or replace a tree to your landscape this spring, you may also consider Redbud, Hawthorn, Yellow-wood, or one of the many native Oaks. We have a wide selection of trees that will fit easily in your car, van or pickup truck for planting this weekend.
