

# *Arctostaphylos uva-ursi*

## Bearberry



- 6 to 12 inches; spread 2 to 4 ft.
- Part shade to full sun
- Does best in poor, acidic, well-drained, infertile soils. Salt tolerant
- Evergreen groundcover
- Small, white tinged pink, urn-shaped flowers, April-May.
- Bright red fruit, late July through August and persist into winter.
