

# *Castanea dentata* American Chestnut



- Formerly 70 to 100 feet, now 20 to 25 feet due to chestnut blight
- Full sun to shade
- Moist to dry soil
- Pale yellow or creamy white, early summer bloom
- Gold fall color

Host three species of hairstreak butterfly larvae and the banded oak dusky wing larvae.
