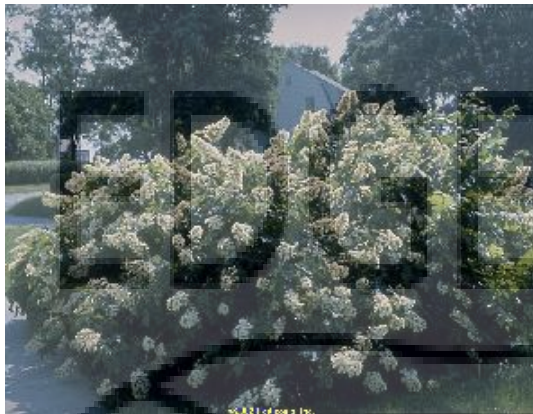


Hydrangea quercifolia

Oakleaf Hydrangea



- 3 to 8 feet tall, fast grower
- Spreads 6 to 8 feet
- Sun to light shade
- Moist to moderately dry soil
- 4 to 12 inch long panicles of white flowers, late May – June changing to pink and then tan
- Large oak shaped leaves change to various shades of red in fall
- Tolerated black walnuts
