

Ilex verticillata Winterberry Holly



- 6 to 10 feet tall by 6 to 10 feet wide
- Part sun
- Average to wet; prefers moist, acidic soil
- Deciduous, native holly prized for the vibrant, persistent, red berries produced on female plants to brighten the winter garden
- Need one male within 50 feet
- Small, inconspicuous whitish flowers, June
- Medium green leaves turn burgundy in fall, dropping early to reveal berries

Larval host for Henry's Elfin butterfly
