

Menispermum canadense Common Moonseed



- 10 to 20 feet twining vine.
- Part to heavy shade
- Adaptable to any well drained soil
- Loose clusters of small, greenish-white, inconspicuous flower
- Non-edible, toxic fruit ripens in September
- Typically grown on a support structure.
- On ground, helps prevent soil erosion on banks.
