

Ostrya virginiana

Hop Hornbeam/Ironwood



- Graceful, understory tree, 25-40 feet tall, 20 to 30 feet wide
- Sun , Part Shade
- Moist to dry, rich, well-drained soils. Drought tolerant.
- Flowers in catkins that remain visible throughout winter. Yellow fall color
- Fruit is a drooping cluster of nutlets enclosed in a papery pod. Resembling fish scales or hops
- Slow growing, salt sensitive
