

Quercus muehlenbergii

Chinquapin Oak, Yellow Oak



- 50 to 80 feet tall
- 50 to 70 foot spread
- Full sun
- Best in well drained soil but is adaptable to many soil conditions
- Dark green, shiny leaves, 4 to 7 inches long turn yellow to orange-brown in fall
- Mature trees develop a rounded form

Larvae host for Gray Hairstreak butterfly

Native to PA
