

Rosa virginiana

Virginia Rose



- 4 to 6 feet tall, 6 to 7 feet spread
- Full sun, part sun
- Moist, well-drained, acidic soil. Salt tolerant
- Pink, single, fragrant blooms in early summer
- Red hips in fall
- Foliage turns purple then orange-red, crimson and yellow in autumn
- Reddish canes are attractive in winter
