

Sassafras albidum

Sassafras



- 35 to 50 feet tall
- Spreads 25 to 40 feet
- Sun to Shade.
- Prefers well drained, can tolerate soggy feet
- Little bunches of yellow-green flower balls scattered profusely over the female tree; more sparsely on the male.
- Dark-blue fruits on scarlet stalks appear on female plants in late summer.
- Can sucker but easily controlled as single tree.
