

Schizachyrium scoparium

'The Blues'

Little Blue Stem



- 2 to 3 feet tall, spreads to 12 inches
- Sun to part shade.
- Drought tolerant; Adaptable to almost all soils but wet.
- Intense blue green in summer, with white, shining seed tufts in the fall.
- Striking color persists through winter.
- Larval Host: Ottoe Skipper, Indian Skipper, Crossline Skipper, Dusted Skipper, Cobweb butterfly, Dixie skipper
