

Schizachyrium scoparium

'Twilight Zone'

Little Blue Stem



- 2 to 3 feet tall by 1 foot wide
- Sun to part shade.
- Drought tolerant; Adaptable to almost all soils but wet.
- Blue green in summer turning to iridescent, silvery mauve
- Radiant mahogany-red with white, shining seed tufts in the fall.
- Striking color persists through winter.
- Tight upright habit, thick blades
- Larval Host: Ottoe Skipper, Indian Skipper, Crossline Skipper, Dusted Skipper, Cobweb butterfly, Dixie skipper
