**False Solomon's Seal**



- 1 to 3 foot arching stem, 1.5 to 2 foot spread
- Part shade, shade
- Average, medium to moist soil
- 2" to 6" cluster of fragrant, tiny, white flowers at the tip of the stem in spring
- Red berries in fall
