

Leucothoe axillaris Coast Dog Hobble



Good with
rhododendron, or
for shady bank.

- 2 to 4 foot high 4 to 6 foot wide
- Full to part shade.
- Prefers moist, acidic well drained organic soil. Evergreen.
- Flowers white April and May.
- Will not withstand drought or dry sweeping winds.
- Almost indistinguishable from *Leucothoe fontanesiana*, but slightly smaller.
- In very humid areas, the plant must have at least six hours of sunlight to discourage leaf spot diseases. Rejuvenate by cutting to the ground after flowering.
