<i>Eurybia sp.</i>	Asters (white wood, Eastern showy, & bigleaf)	Seed
<i>Helianthus sp.</i>	Sunflowers (hairy, woodland, swamp, & sunchokes)	Seed
<i>Lobelia sp.</i>	Cardinal Flower and Great Blue Lobelia	Seed
<i>Monarda sp.</i>	Beebalm (bergamot, Bradbury's, scarlet, & dotted)	Seed
<i>Panicum virgatum</i>	Switchgrass	Cover, Seed
<i>Schizachyrium scoparium</i>	Little Blue Stem	Cover, Seed
<i>Rudbeckia sp.</i>	Black and Brown-eyed Susans; Giant Coneflower	Seed
<i>Solidago sp.</i>	Goldenrods	Cover, Seed
