



Arctostaphylos uva-ursi 'Massachusetts'

'Massachusetts' Bearberry

- 6 to 12 inches tall. Spreading two or more feet.
- Full sun to very light shade
- Best in poor, infertile, well drained, acidic, sandy soil
- Slow growing, evergreen groundcover
- Small, pinkish-white flowers in April-May followed by bright red berries
- 'Massachusetts' is disease resistant
