

Callicarpa americana

American Beautyberry

- 3 to 6 feet tall (possibly up to 9ft)
- 3 to 5 foot spread
- Full sun to part shade
- Dry to moist, slightly acidic soil
- Pinkish white blooms in early summer, followed by showy clusters of bright purple berries
- Great multi-stemmed, understory shrub
- Native from Virginia south to Florida
- Not reliably hardy in zone 6; often dies back in winter; best planted in a protected spot against a south-facing wall/foundation
