

## *Quercus phellos*

### Willow Oak

- 40 to 60 feet tall
- 30 to 60 feet spread
- Full sun to part shade
- Prefers moist to wet, well-drained soil but tolerates drier soils once established
- Fall color is usually yellow-orange fading to a yellow brown
- Long, narrow leaves resembling foliage of willows, less clean up than other oaks



Larval host: Imperial moth; banded, Edward's, White-M, and Gray hairstreaks, Horace's and Juvenal's duskywings
